11. Travel details

By plane: Dortmund Airport is the closest airport to Wuppertal, approximately 40km, Köln/ Bonn is about 60km and Düsseldorf about 50km away. From these airports you can either go by rental car or take the train to Wuppertal main station/ 'Wuppertal Hauptbahnhof'. For further details, see travel infos by train below.

By car: From Highway 1 (A1) take the exit No. 93 'Wuppertal-Langerfeld' and take a right towards Wuppertal city center ("Zentrum"). Follow this road until you pass under a bridge with a sign saying 'Autocenter Jungmann'. You will find a 'Lidl' supermarket on the left short after. Take a left at the next intersection towards 'Remscheid, Solingen, Ronsdorf, Beyenburg'. Follow this road until you see the climbing gym on your left. Parking is either available on the side of the road or on the parking lot right in front of the gym. For that you have to take a left at the traffic light.

By train & bus: You can catch a train to Wuppertal main station from every major station in Germany. From here on (if not possible directly) you may take a connecting train to 'Wuppertal Oberbarmen'. From here the buses 602, 616, 626 (heading towards 'Schmitteborn, Beyenburg or Radevormwald') leaving on the bridge under the suspension railway tracks, will take you directly to the climbing gym. Get off the bus at the fourth stop called 'Bockmühlbrücke'. You only have to go a few meters back to the intersection from where you can see the climbing hall. By the way: Wuppertal is world famous for its overhead suspension railway!
